## New Forest Butterfly Transect Group – Week 11

A big increase in counts this week, even on the heathland transects.

Plenty of Silver-studded Blue about and a great count of fourteen White Admiral in Kings Copse. Silver-washed Fritillary are beginning to emerge as well and Ringlet have been recorded at Breamore & Godshill.

A total of 534 butterflies were seen at a rate of 7.77/km. This compares very favourably with the last three years (0.90; 4.21; 2.18). May it well continue!

We seem to have lost Green Hairstreak, but a lone Orange-tip turned up at Blackwater.

Hopefully another good week for White Admiral ahead and numbers should also be boosted with more Silver-washed Fritillary and Ringlet on the wing.

Marbled White are flying now and Gatekeeper will be along very soon.
